The Beginning of Lions Clubs International

In response to social problems created by World War I and rapid industrialization, a Chicago businessman named Melvin Jones invites business clubs from around the USA to a meeting where the Association of Lions Clubs is formed.



Matrika Prasad Koirala

First Lion President of Nepal

The first Lion President of Nepal, Late Lion Matrika Prasad Koirala was born on 1st January 1912 in Biratnagar, Morang, the eastern part of Nepal. He took the opportunity to become the First Lion President of Nepal by establishing the Lions Club of Biratnagar in 1971. Lion P.C.Jain of LC Ajmer was the extension chairperson of Lions Club of Biratnagar.

History of LEO clubs



- 1957 First Leo club founded by Glenside Lions Club in Abington, Pennsylvania, USA with 35 high school boys
- Coach Jim Graver and Lion William Ernst (Glenside Lions Club)
- <u>December 5, 1957</u>

1964 – The Leo Club Program became an official district project and started to grow rapidly in Pennsylvania and other surrounding areas

1967 – Leo Club Program became an official program of Lions Clubs International





History of LEO clubs in Nepal

1971

First Lions Club in Nepal was chartered in Biratnagar (Nepal was affiliated to District 322 A and E in India) by Late Matrika P. Koirala 1972

Second Lions Club of Nepal-Lions Club Kathmandu was chartered

1973

First Leo Club was organized in Kathmandu 1976

First Nepali Late Lion Dr. Anajani Kumar Sharma became District Governor and later Multiple Council Chair 1982

Nepal receives Provisional District status 1987

Nepal receives status of full fledged district 325 1997

Nepal was granted Multiple District 325 status with District A and B by LCI 2012

Multiple District 325 was further bifurcated to four districts in the name of District A1, A2 and B1, B2

The first leo club in Nepal is Leo Club of Kathmandu, started in 1973 sponsored by Lions Club of Kathmandu.

Leo Club of Kathmandu Himalayas Patan is the oldest existing Leo Club of Nepal.

At first, Leo Clubs in Nepal were included in District 321, 322-E of Bihar, India.

Currently, since L.Y. 2022/2023, Leo District has been bifractured from four districts to fifteen districts (i.e. 325C, 325 D, 325 E, 325 F, 325 G, 325 H, 325 I, 325 J, 325 K, 325 L, 325 M, 325 N, 325 P 325 R, and 325 H).

CLUB PRESIDENT

- Leo<u>elected</u> by fellow club members to manage club and board meetings.
- advises other club
 <u>officers concerning their</u>
 <u>responsibilities and</u>
 <u>facilitates decision-making processes.</u>
- Leo club presidents may also call upon other active <u>Lions or past Leo</u> <u>club leaders for</u> guidance.
- By using these resources, presidents enhance their own leadership skills and help develop club members into a successful team.



CLUB VICE PRESIDENT

- Leo who <u>assists the</u>
 <u>president</u> throughout the
 year.
- The vice president assumes the duties of president if the elected president cannot complete the term.

CLUB SECRETARY

- Leo who maintains club records and meeting minutes.
- The secretary maintains records of <u>officers</u>, <u>committee</u>, <u>members</u>, <u>attendance</u>, <u>and service</u> <u>activities</u>.
- The secretary is also responsible for reporting Leo club officers, members and service activities to the Leo Club Program Department and the sponsoring Lions club.



CLUB TREASURER

- Leo who receives and deposits all money into one of two accounts, which must be kept separate:
- Administrative account, which contains new member fees and dues collected from club members.
- Activity account, which contains money collected from public fundraising projects.
- Each month, the treasurer <u>submits a financial</u> <u>statement to the Leo club</u> board of directors.

 - This annual fee of US\$100 (or national currency equivalent) is automatically billed in July to all Lions clubs that sponsor an active Leo club.
- District Dues form Club
 - 150 per member
 - Factor for voting Rights
- Leo Club Dues
 - member fees to meet administrative costs
 - Membership dues and assessments should be nominal and for the sole purpose of covering administrative expenses
 - Unpaid Leo member dues will result in the forfeiture of voting privileges and a Leo is considered not in good standing until dues are paid







COMMON REASONS FOR LEAVING

HOW TO PREVENT IT

Disorganized Club Leadership Leo club officers should seek advice from the Leo club advisor, sponsoring Lions club, Leo district officers and district Leo club chairperson. The sponsoring Lions club or Leo district leaders can provide additional leadership training for club officers.

Inadequate Orientation

Leo club officers should provide a thorough orientation for new members and conduct an impressive induction ceremony.

Social Cliques

Leo club officers should combine new and old members to serve on committees.

Lack of Recognition

Leo club officers should praise members and present awards whenever appropriate.

Lack of Club Membership

Leo club officers can meet with the Leo club advisor and district Leo club chairperson to discuss suggestions for growth and development, including new ways to promote the Leo club and to attract new members.

Lack of Important Activities

Leo club officers can form a committee to study local needs.

Lack of Interest in a Club Project Leo leaders can consider altering or adding projects using ideas from Leo members.

Individual Leo and Leo Advisor Awards

International President Award: There is a special recognition opportunity available to Leo club presidents of newly formed clubs. The International President is awarding a Presidential Certificate of Appreciation to Leo club presidents when they add all of the originating Leo members to their club roster within 30 days of the club's formation. To qualify, Leo members should be entered into the online reporting system.

Leos of the Year Award: A multiple district council of governors or single district (that is not part of a multiple district) may nominate one high-achieving Leo each year for this medallion and certificate award. Applications must be submitted by March 1.

Congratulations to all the current award recipients!

Leo Club President Achievement Award: A Leo club president who meets specific requirements during their year in office may be awarded this certificate by the Leo club advisor with the approval of the sponsoring Lions club president. Award criteria categories include leadership development, membership extension, administration and Leo club activities.

Leo October Membership Growth Award: Leo club advisors may present this award to any Leo who recruits three or more new members who are reported in the online reporting system during the month of October. For a Leo to earn this award, Leo club advisors must submit the nomination form by November 15.

Leo Award of Honor: Leos may nominate a fellow Leo member for this award to recognize their outstanding accomplishments during the year. The lapel medal can be purchased from Club Supplies.

Leo Club Advisor Outstanding Service Award: The Leo club president may present this award to Leo club advisors who meet specific requirements and demonstrate outstanding service in guiding and developing their Leo clubs. Nomination forms are accepted April-June each year.

Leo Club Advisor Five-Year Service Award: Sponsoring Lions club presidents may honor Leo club advisors who successfully complete five years of dedicated service with this award. Sponsoring Lions club presidents should complete and submit this application to obtain the five-year service pin and certificate.

Leo Club Extension Award: Sponsoring Lions club presidents and Leo club advisors receive these certificates upon official certification of a new Leo club. The sponsoring Lions club can request additional certificates by emailing leo@lionsclubs.org for anyone it wishes to thank for assisting in organizing the new Leo club.

Serving Together Award: A banner patch featuring the Leo and Lions club logo is awarded to both the Leo club and the sponsoring Lions club for successful completion of joint projects and other types of activities supporting Leo and Lion collaboration. Award requirements are on the application. Ideas to successfully work together can be found on the Leo and Lion Positive Collaboration webpage.

Leo Club and Sponsoring Lions Club Anniversary Patches: Leo clubs who have achieved the fifth anniversary of their certification and their sponsoring Lions club can receive anniversary patches sent from the Leo Club Program staff. Patches are sent at anniversaries in multiples of five years thereafter. To receive the anniversary patch, please complete the following form.
